A medical degree typically takes four years to complete, and part-time medical school does not exist. Medical school at night is also not an option, although you can earn your pre-med degree at night. Even for medical schools in the United States that offer a five-year medical degree or a combined medical and bachelor's degree, you will still need to bring a full-time program to finish on time. Below, we discuss the details of attending medical school, including pre-med requirements and alternative schooling options. Becoming a doctor in the United States requires four years of education and training. The first two years are spent in class and focus on reading, study and lab work; the last two years are devoted to practical experience in hospitals and clinics. While searching for medical school length, requirements and options, we were unable to find any medical school in the United States that offer a part-time participation opportunity. This is because proper training is essential for doctors, and medical school is only one step in the long process of becoming a doctor. After completing your degree, which typically takes four years, the second step is to get a four-year degree. In your final year of medical school, you will choose a specialty and apply for residency programs at this is the third step. The fourth step is spending three to seven years doing a residency before becoming a doctor, then continuing your education with certifications and continuing education throughout your career. So if you want to be a doctor, you are looking at 11 to 15 years of schooling and training after completing high school. Once you're a doctor, you'll need to get a license in your state and do continuing medical education classes; this fifth and final step is underway. While the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC) does not directly state that part-time medical school is not permitted, it does set the standards and requirements that medical schools must meet in order to become accredited schools. One of AAMC's accreditation standards is that educators at every medical school should be able to strengthen the complex subjects of study over and over again so that students can successfully retain this important information. Going to school part time can make it difficult for educators to reinforce some complex and critical topics that students need to learn and commit to memory in medical school. Other medical-related diplomas you can earn part time You can't become an MD or DO by attending part time school. However, note that other medical schools and medical fields have degree courses and part-time certification. We were not able to find any medical school during our search which allow only at night generally, the first two years of medical school were spent in class during the day, respecting from a set and limited program. Although this does not give you the opportunity to go to school part time, it gives you the opportunity to work part time at night (if you are able to manage at the top of the course and study.) Many schools offer pre-med or night science degree classes, but not medical degree courses. Other schools, such as georgetown university, offer a series of medical-based conferences at night taught by their medical school professors. Note that these are for anyone in the community to come to know what medical students study, and are not part of earning a medical degree. While continuing training credits can be issued to participate in such programs, academic credit is usually not released. Combined degree options some schools offer combined degree and medical degree programs. with a combined degree program, you can earn pre-med degree and your back-to-back medical degree at the same school. both degrees are full time and the course load is intense, but making a combined program can save a total year. in some schools with combined degrees (boston university, for example,) it will take seven years to complete the two degrees, rather than the eight years that would take us to do it separately. However, in other schools where degrees are combined (state of wayne, for example,) it still takes eight total years.
