Origins in 1828, a moderation was expected to prevail in transferring the political power of a US president to another. [10] The separation between the political activity and civil service was made stronger with the 1939 Hatch Law which banned federal officials to engage in many political activities. The spoil system survived much longer in many states, counties and municipalities, such as Tammany Hall Machine, which survived until 1950, when New York has reformed his own civil service. Illinois modernized his bureaucracy in 1917 under Frank Lowden, but Chicago kept patronage in the city government to the city agreed to end the practice at Shakman Decrees of 1972 and 1983.
