Diatomacea land This product is not a poison or a chemical of any kind, and the way it works is quite interesting. Under a microscope, a stack of these empty shells looks just like broken glass - which is fundamentally, since the glass is made of the same material. When an insect strips through the diatomacea land, the jagged shells the outer layer of the insect, and dies. This material has been used as an insecticide for a century. Are hornworm caterpillars dangerous? even if the tomato worm has what seems to be a stimulus coming out of its tail, it is completely harmless. there are some other species, however, which are poisonous and can give you a rather ugly sting if you touch them or brush against them. the manipulation of the caterpillars is fine if you know with which it is, but otherwise it is better to hide the gloves or avoid letting the caterpillar contact the skin, especially if it is hairy or has thorns. Despite their size and horn on their backside, the tomato berry caterpillars are 100% harmless and can't bite, bite, or hurt you in any way! Why does it have a horn? the curved tail or horn on the worm's rump is not a stimulus, although scientists think it might look as good as one to provide protection to the caterpillar. there is no puncture, or even a sharp tip to the horn, so its oo as a protective device is questionable. Phil on April 14, 2018: Moths lay their eggs under the leaf of tomato plants and that's why you don't see them until they started chewing your tomato plants to death. These basic green tards can double in terms of alternate days, so you have to keep your tomato plants every day. I treat my problem by covering my tomato plants with a certain fine knitted flag that allows the light, to the air and the water to penetrate the material. It cost a few dollars but I can't look at my garden 24 hours a day and if you buy a decent fabric to last a few years so you can sue him more and more times. Organically garden but I don't see the point of spraying the Neem or orange oil on my plants all the time especially since it often rains here in the area of Houston. The fine knitted network does everything for me and the tomatoes are self-placed, so you don't have to worry about this. However, I increased my yield once the flowers appear, take a toothbrush and an electric toothbrush on the upper part of the flowers to simulate a bee and pollen cash and help to put the fruits. I do it early in the morning or at sunset.
