What channel is canelo vs smith on

Callum Smith will attempt to become a unified world champion for the first time in his career when he takes on Canelo Alvarez in San Antonio on Saturday.The Liverpool-born fighter was a British amateur champion and a Commonwealth silver medalist but controversially missed out on qualification for the London 2012 Olympic Games.He subsequently turned professional, just as his three older brothers Paul, Liam and Stephen had, and became English super-middleweight champion in just his eighth professional bout. Venue: Alamodome, San Antonio, TXTV: Online only in the UKLive stream: DAZN subscription available here for £1.99 a month in the UK, and includes access to Golovkin vs Szerezeta on Friday 18 December and Garcia vs Campbell on Saturday 2 JanuaryFight time: Around 4am on Sunday morningi predicts: A late stoppage in favour of Canelo Smith went on to acquire British and European honours before entering the World Boxing Super Series, a tournament that pitted him against George Groves in the final, where he sprung an upset by stopping the Londoner in the seventh round to claim the Muhammad Ali Trophy as well as the WBA world super-middleweight title.He has since defended the title successfully twice but faces the biggest challenge to his unbeaten 27-0 professional record when he takes on Canelo, regarded by many as the pound-for-pound best fighter in the world, with his WBA and the vacant WBC strap on the line.The Mexican has just one defeat on his 56-fight record and that came against Floyd Mayweather Jr back in 2013. Since then, he has won world titles at super-welterweight, middleweight, super-middleweight and light-heavyweight.What to watch - the tactical breakdownDespite his guided tour of various weight categories, Canelo has not often had to deal with the physical mismatch of someone like Smith. When he fought brother Liam in 2016 he was marginally the smaller man but Callum got the taller genes and stands at 6ft 3in tall, some six inches taller than his opponent.He is also estimated to have a shorter reach than Smith by some seven-and-a-half inches, something the proud Scouser has always said would work in his favour in any potential fight.“Canelo is a good fighter, great to watch and I do rate him,” Smith said in May before the fight was confirmed.“The thing is, I rate [Vasy] Lomachenko, but I don’t believe he’ll win junior welterweight or welterweight titles. There’s only so much size you can give away where your ability makes up for it. I see size as being a big advantage for me [against Canelo].”Callum Smith will be the considerably larger man in the ring (Photo: Reuters)Once the fight was eventually confirmed and a date set, Smith said he reckoned Alvarez would have been better off staying in the 160lb middleweight division rather than taking on someone like him.“I think stylistically I’m hard to beat, and I think the best Canelo Alvarez is at 160.” Smith said in November.“There’s a lot of big people at 168. I’m big, and I got the skills to go with it as well. So, I think tactically, and stylistically I’m in this fight to win it, and I believe I will.”Alvarez will draw on his experience of fighting Sergey Kovalev in his last bout, when he claimed the WBO light-heavyweight title with an 11th-round knockout of an opponent of superior height and reach, although the Russian is still not as tall or lengthy as Smith.On that occasion, Canelo was in danger of losing the fight on points before a fearsome two-punch combination knocked Kovalev out and rescued the victory for the Mexican, his 53rd in the paid ranks.He was accused of failing to work hard enough to earn rounds on the judges’ scorecards and given that Smith has gone 12 rounds in three of his last five fights, Canelo should not expect to rely on a knockout. Instead, he will look to use his movement and counter-punching to get inside the long jab of Smith and regularly score points from close range, where he is able to generate so much power.Smith meanwhile will look to box the opposite fight, at range where Canelo cannot get to him. If the Mexican does get up close, he will look to hold on and clinch to shut down the more dangerous punches.There is a danger that the early rounds could, a bit like Canelo vs Kovalev, be a little cagey, with Smith wary of being caught on the counter and Alvarez moving out of range. However, if both men look to engage as the bout wears on, it could turn into a classic.Follow i sport on Facebook for more boxing news, interviews and featuresMore on boxing For the third time since December, Canelo Alvarez will step into the ring to face Billy Joe Saunders. The unification fight will take place at AT&T Stadium in Dallas, TX. The last time in the ring, Alvarez was able to decisively beat Avni Yildirim on February 27, with Yildirim tapping after the third round. Before that, he defeated Callum Smith by unanimous decision. That had been his first fight since defeating Sergey Kovalev in November 2019. As for Saunders, he has held world championships in two different weight classes and the WBO super middleweight title, which he has held since 2019. The fight between the two boxers will begin at 11 pm ET on Saturday with a card starting at 8 pm ET. The entire event will be available through DAZN, which owns the exclusive rights to broadcast the fight in the United States. Smith, who is unbeaten in eight years, beat John Ryder last year to retain his WBA (Super) and The Ring super-middleweight titles. But Canelo will be a very different test. The remarkable Mexican won his 56th fight when he sav off Sergey Kovalev in his last bout to become a four-weight world champion. He’ll be looking to add Smith’s title – plus the vacant WBC super middleweight crown – to his glittering collection on Saturday night. Unbeaten WBA (Super) and The Ring super-middleweight titleholder Smith will defend his title against the sport’s biggest star in a match-up worthy of closing out what has been a testing year for everyone, including the combat sports industry. Alvarez has vowed to take on the biggest challenges the sport has to offer him, and attempting to put a blemish on the spotless professional record of Muhammad Ali Trophy winner Smith is certainly a sizeable mountain to climb. Britain’s Smith last stepped into the ring on Nov. 23 of last year with a successful title defense via unanimous decision over John Ryder in his home town of Liverpool. Mexico’s Alvarez, meanwhile, broke down and stopped the once-fearsome Sergey Kovalev to capture the WBO light-heavyweight title three weeks prior to Smith-Ryder in Las Vegas. The colossal contest comes just 24 hours after Alvarez rival Gennady Golovkin makes his own return to action against Kamil Szerezeta, making it a huge weekend of big fights for DAZN subscribers. Alvarez halted Smith’s brother Liam in 2016 at light-middleweight, and the siblings have unsurprisingly discussed this upcoming bout at great length to ensure the champ is prepared for his toughest challenger to date. “My brother Liam has been in with him and as much you can watch someone over the years on video, it’s always different being in with them,” said Callum to the media. “Liam has seen him up close, he knows little things he does very well and stuff he feels I can capitalize on.
