[8] On 12 October 2011, Apple updated the iOS app to version 1.5, adding the feature of iCloud "Documents in the Cloud". The IOS pages have been updated to version 1.6 March 7, 2012, and will only work on IOS 5.1 or later. The pages for OS X has been updated to version 4.3 on December 4, 2012, to support pages for iOS 1.7, which was released the same day. Pages for iOS 1.7.1 introduced a better compatibility with Word and Pages for Mac version 1.7.2, published March 7, 2013, it has just added stability improvements and bugfixes. On October 23, 2013 Apple released a redesign with 5.0 and made free pages for anyone with an iOS device.
