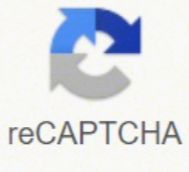

Friend and fiend, alive and live.

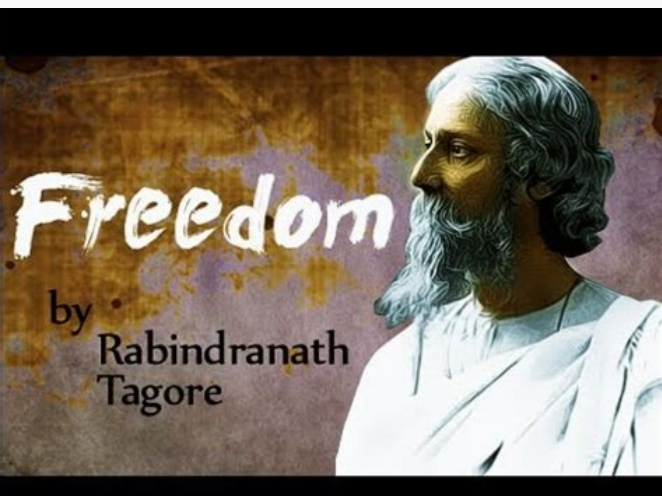
